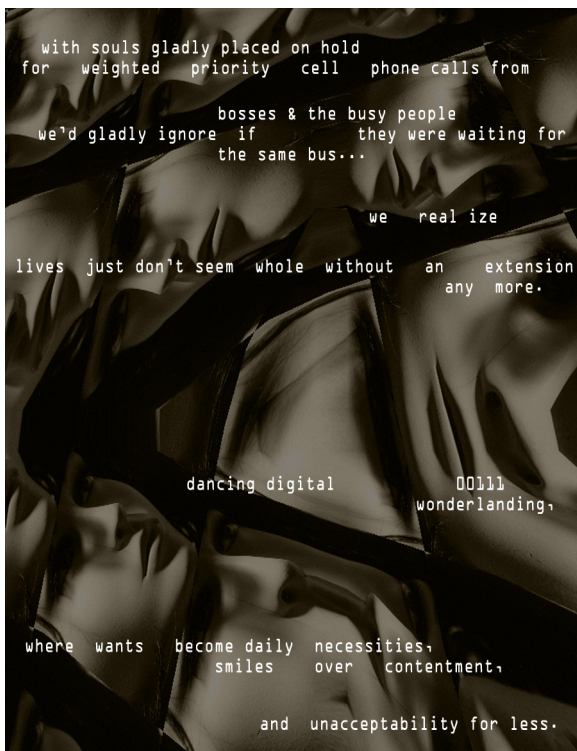


your place in the world
